SECTION 1

ORS 468.010(2) is repealed:

[(2) The term of office of a member shall be four years, but the members of the commission may be removed by the Governor. Before the expiration of the term of a member, the Governor shall appoint a successor to assume the duties of the member on July 1 next following. A member shall be eligible for reappointment, but no member shall serve more than two consecutive terms. In case of a vacancy for any cause, the Governor shall make an appointment to become immediately effective for the unexpired term.]

SECTION 2

The following shall replace ORS Section 468.010(2)

- (2) The term of office of a member shall be four years. Before the expiration of the term of a member, the Governor shall appoint a successor to assume the duties of the member on July 1 next following. A member shall be eligible for reappointment, but no member shall serve more than two consecutive terms. In case of a vacancy for any cause, the Governor shall make an appointment to become immediately effective for the unexpired term.
 - (a) No two members shall reside in the same Congressional district.
 - (b) At least one member shall be from the mining community
 - (c) At least one member shall be from the agricultural community
 - (d) At least one member shall be from the manufacturing community
 - (e) At least one member shall be from the timber community

SECTION 3

The requirements set in SECTION 2 of this Act shall be applied to members replacing the membership at the time this Act is adopted.
